

Grannies

What should be included:

- Book – Grannies
- Stuffed Bluey & Bingo
- Grannie Shaws
- “Draw A Granny Portrait” page
- Crayons
- Book – Look I’m Happy
- Bluey’s Charades Game

Book and Activity:

Read – Grannies:

The book, Grannies, has Bluey and Bingo dressing up as some of their favorite characters – the Grannies (Janet and Rita). They are up to their usual granny activities when Bluey and Bingo get into an argument over whether their real Nana can do the Floss Dance. They find out that you are never too old to try something new.

Activities:

- After reading the book, let your child dress up the stuffed Bluey and Bingo as the “Grannies” and try acting out some of the things the grannies did in the book.
- Watch other Bluey episodes (found on Disney+ or YouTube) that have the Grannies in them and play out some of the things you see the grannies do: **“Bus” (Season 2, Episode 22), “Granny Mobile” (Season 3, Episode 22)**
- You and your child can use blankets and pretend to be the “Grannies”. Try making up some new ideas of what you think the Grannies might do (a new dance, game, etc.)
- Using the crayons and “Draw A Granny Portrait” paper, try drawing what you would look like as a Granny

Social Emotional Activity:

- Using the book “Look I’m Happy”, turn to each page and try:
 - Talking about each emotion
 - Making each emotion with your face and body (seeing it in the mirror)
 - Talking about what things make you feel each emotion

Bluey Fun:

Bluey’s Charades Game

- Before you begin the game of Charades, try watching the Bluey Episode called **“Charades” (Season 2, Episode 11)**, which can be found on YouTube or Disney+
This episode will not only show your child what the game of charades is but also has a good example how sometimes things might need to be changed a little so that **EVERYONE can be included 😊*
- To play Charades:
 - Place the cards face down
 - Then take turns picking up a card (keeping it hidden)
 - Then act out what is shown on the card
 - Feel free to modify the game in any way needed to have FUN
